- A Sikorsky MH-60S Helicopter from NAS Whidbey Island will **land** at the **University of Washington IMA Sports Field #4** at approximately **2:30 pm**
- There will be an info session at **Noon in EEB 303** to discuss Naval aviation, nuclear power, surface warfare, medical, and other exciting Navy career opportunities. Attendees will be issued a **"VIP pass"** for first access to the helicopter and crew upon landing. **Pizza and drinks will be provided.**
- Time permitting, anyone unable to attend the info session will also have a chance to tour the MH-60S and speak with the aircrew about Naval aviation.
- The event will conclude with a guest speaker (TBD) and presentation in **GUG 220**
- All events are completely free, with no cost or obligation required.
